School Banking News

Happy New Year!

This year, thanks to the power of social media, School Banking has five teams of school banking volunteers to assist with processing. Thank you to the new volunteers who put their hand up to help with School Banking this year and welcome back to last year's volunteers who agreed to continue to help with School Banking.

A few housekeeping items –

- Please include your child's student banking id number on their deposit slip. A video of how to complete the deposit slips correctly can be found here www.bit.ly/deposit-slip
- Complete the deposit slip using blue or black pen only
- If your child is banking for the first time include their Bank Account BSB number and Account Number on the Deposit Slip
- School banking days are on **Tuesday** but send your child's deposit bank in on **Mondays** for collection, deposit books will be returned to your child's class on Tuesday after processing
- The Term 1 reward items are the Cyber Handball and the Colour Change Markers, remember your child must have 10 reward points before they can order a reward item
- The usual reward cards issued by the Commonwealth Bank in previous years are no longer available. Instead a Parent Information Sheet has been provided with a section that includes a reward card that can be cut out of the information sheet. The Parent Information Sheets are being distributed to Kindy to Year Two children. If your child hasn't received a Parent Information Sheet and would like one, I will leave some at the School Front Office for collection. I have also printed up rewards cards which can be sent home in your child's deposit book upon request.
