## Reading – a skill for life!

#### Today's tip from Di Vickers:

If your child makes a mistake when reading aloud, allow time for self-correction. Wait about 5 seconds so that your child has **time** to puzzle out what **might** make sense. If your child is thinking about making sense, they



can guess a word or two and not lose meaning. Good readers often do this. (If a mistake makes sense, you don't always have to correct it.)


